FROM THE CEO & THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD

Dear Friends of Red Door Community,

Thank you for your ongoing commitment to our organization as we continue to provide our **FREE** comprehensive cancer support program to anyone and everyone impacted by cancer. This past year we have continued to reach more people... in more ways... and in more places by providing our program virtually, as COVID still presents itself as a threat to those who are living with cancer.

The transition to our new name, **Red Door Community**, has been a success as evident by our continued double-digit growth and broader reach beyond New York City. While we were an in-person organization for **25 years**, our transition to a virtual program has greatly increased our accessibility to the special community we serve. It has also allowed us to **enhance our program offerings by 30%** now that we are no longer limited by physical space for in person programs.

This year was also a year where we were able to expand our **FREE** individual counseling sessions to children, teens, adults living with cancer and the bereft. The demand for individual counseling has grown tremendously, especially for children and teens living with a parent diagnosed with cancer or who have lost a parent to cancer – a population that is often overlooked.

Our Annual Impact demonstrates more than ever the demand for our free cancer support program:

- **20,000+** individuals served
- **960** support groups
- **850** educational lectures & healthy lifestyle workshops
- **300** individual counseling sessions
- **30%** increase in program offerings

This year, the greater accessibility of our free cancer support program has demonstrated the value of our virtual program and our ability to build a community of support virtually. However, we continue to look for opportunities to bring our members together, by returning to in person member events such as **Celebration of Members** and **Remembrance Gathering**, both of which were incredibly well-received.

The past three years of the pandemic has also shown us the strength of our community of members, our generous donors, our volunteers, and our staff. It is this unwavering commitment to **Red Door Community** that has helped to not only sustain our program, but to expand it to serve more individuals who are impacted by cancer and their families. We are forever grateful for your support and generosity that makes this all possible.

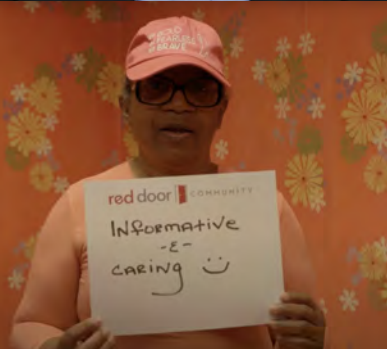

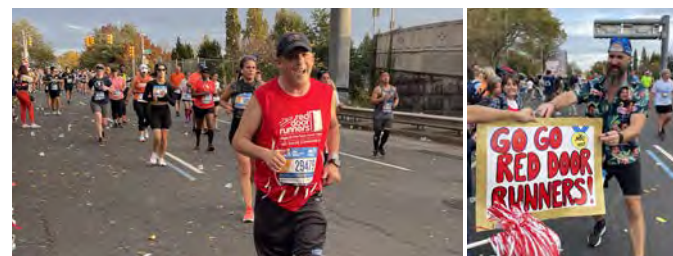

2022 Celebrating Women Working & Living With Cancer Luncheon

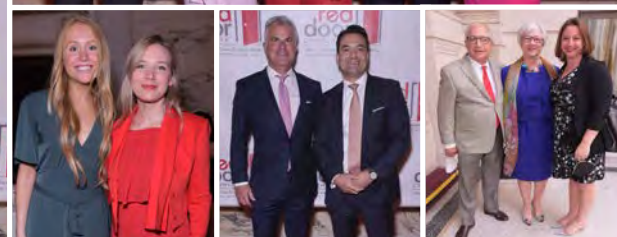

2022 Winter Wonderland (Member Event)

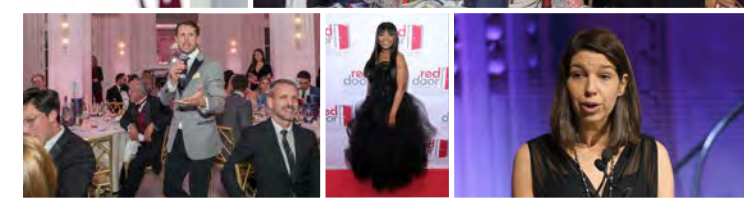
